

BIKRAM YOGA METHOD INSTRUCTOR 2009 RECERTIFICATION

As a Certified Bikram Yoga Method Instructor, Bikram requires that all Teachers, re-certify every 3 years in order to hold a valid certificate. If you are a graduate from Class of 1994 thru 2006, and you have not recertified in the last three years, than you will need to recertify as soon as possible.

From now on re-certification can only be accomplished at a special recertification seminar given by Bikram and Rajashree at headquarters. You may recertify as often as you like, but it is mandatory that you recertify three years from the date of your last recertification or from your graduation date.

The cost for the recertification seminar is \$250. This does not include travel expenses or room and board. We ask that you pay by check or credit card. All checks should be made out to: Bikram's Yoga College of India, and mailed directly to HQ.

Below is a list of items required for recertification:

- Registration Form
- Teacher Evaluation Form (Mandatory for everyone, including: people not currently teaching, studio owners, and senior teachers, you must find a way to obtain a current evaluation or you can not recertify. This should be done by someone who is not your employee or family member as that is a conflict of interest, and sent directly to Ainslie@bikramyoga.com at HQ)
- Copy of diploma or last recertification certificate
(If you don't have it, you can purchase a duplicate from Shelly@bikramyoga.com)
- Signed Code of Ethics form (passed out at the seminar.)
- Signed and initialed recertification agreement.
- \$250 Recertification Fee
